This is St Pancras International. Eurostar's new central London station will be just 2h 15 from the heart of Paris; 1h 51 from the centre of Brussels; and 1h 20 from Lille.

Also in November, we'll be opening Ebbsfleet International, our second station in Kent. It's less than 3 miles from Junction 2 of the M25 and it's also a stone's throw from Bluewater shopping centre and the Dartford Crossing. For travellers from southern England it will soon be the fastest way to Europe.
