FRANCE

To make your Gallic escapades smooth and simple, high-speed TGVs offer easy connections from Lille Europe and Paris stations to 100s of destinations throughout France. Whichever direction you choose you'll find a captivating corner of this versatile country waiting to be discovered. And this year, the new TGV Est is the star attraction. Raise a glass of bubbly to this high-speed line which links Paris to the Champagne region in 40 mins flat and arrives in Strasbourg in just 2h 20.

GERMANY

Change trains at Brussels for a short break to Köln (Cologne). As you are whisked through open fields, plan your holiday from the comfort of your seat. Will you make a beeline for the Dom, or unravel art gems in the Museum Ludwig? You're the only one who holds the answer. High-speed trains operate up to 10 services per day between Brussels-Midi/Zuid and Cologne.

BELGIUM

Rolling countryside, heavenly food and the birthplace of spa breaks; all the ingredients you need for a pampering treat. At least two trains per hour run between Brussels-Midi/Zuid and Ghent (35min.), Charleroi (45min.), Bruges (55min.), Antwerp (55min.), Namur (1h 05) and Liège (1h 05).

For culture, for adventure, for nightlife, The Netherlands has it all. Direct services operate at least once an hour between Brussels-Midi/Zuid and Rotterdam (2h), The Hague (2h 20) and Amsterdam (3h).

Wednesday, **14 November 2007** will be a big day for Eurostar and the UK. It's the day we launch services from St Pancras International in central London and the day Eurostar starts running on High Speed 1, the UK's first high-speed line.

This will mean that journey times to the Continent will be reduced by at least **20 minutes**, resulting in even more punctual, even faster, more seamless journeys.

We will be moving from Waterloo International overnight on 13 November 2007 to cause minimum disruption to our travellers.

And to add a little sparkle to your day you will be able to visit Europe's longest champagne bar, which overlooks the hustle and bustle of the platforms. St Pancras International has the best connectivity of all the central London stations. It has 6 Underground lines and is close to 7 mainline operators at St Pancras International, King's Cross and Euston.
